SUMMER LAW PROGRAMS

The following "open enrollment" courses are taught by professors from the University of California, Davis, School of Law, legal experts from major law firms, public officials and/or corporate executives. These courses are open to anyone in the legal and business professions.

Orientation in U.S.A. Law

JULY 8 – AUGUST 4, 2018

This four-week program offers:

- More than 170 hours of classes, seminars and on-site observations about the fundamentals of the U.S. legal system
- Preparation for LL.M. studies in the areas of legal research and writing, oral presentations, participation in the Socratic method, LexisNexis and Westlaw computer training, briefing cases and how to succeed in law school
- Other areas of specialization in business and trade, the U.S. criminal justice system and judicial management

Specialized Courses in International Commercial Law

These two-week courses are for knowledgeable practitioners who wish to gain familiarity with complex international and U.S. business and legal transactions, as well as an understanding of international trade, commerce, finance and investments. Program topics are offered in three sequential years as follows:

- Structuring an International Joint Venture
AUGUST 5 – 18, 2018
- Global Trading System: Substance and Dispute Resolution
AUGUST 2019
- Financing International Transactions
AUGUST 2020

English for Legal Professionals

JUNE 24 – JULY 7, 2018

Designed for practicing lawyers and law students, this program provides an ideal training ground for learning legal terminology in English. This is an outstanding preliminary course for those continuing on with the Orientation in U.S.A. Law program. The English for Legal Professionals program strictly focuses on improving English language and communication skills.

Licensing Academy in Intellectual Property and Technology Transfer

JUNE 17 – 30, 2018

A two-week program to provide international lawyers, technology managers and scientific professionals in the public sector or small-to-medium enterprises with a better understanding of successful U.S. models of intellectual property management.

GRADUATE PROGRAM

Master of Laws (LL.M.)

AUGUST – MAY

During this 10-month program, students:

- Obtain advanced knowledge of the U.S. legal system in a curriculum that integrates American and international law students at all levels of study
- Develop expertise in an area of interest
- Engage in special projects and original research

The program curriculum is designed to meet each student's unique goals. Two-year option and spring start are available. We encourage students to apply by January 10th and will accept applications thereafter, until the academic year begins.
